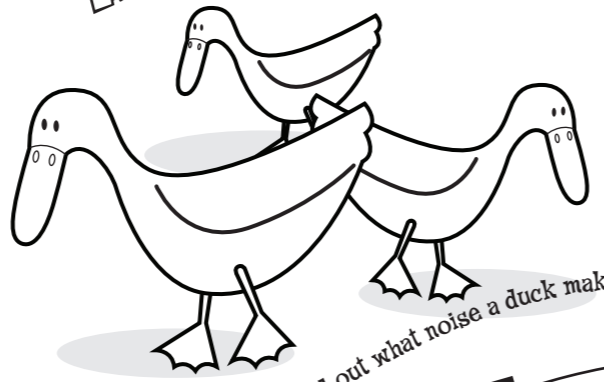

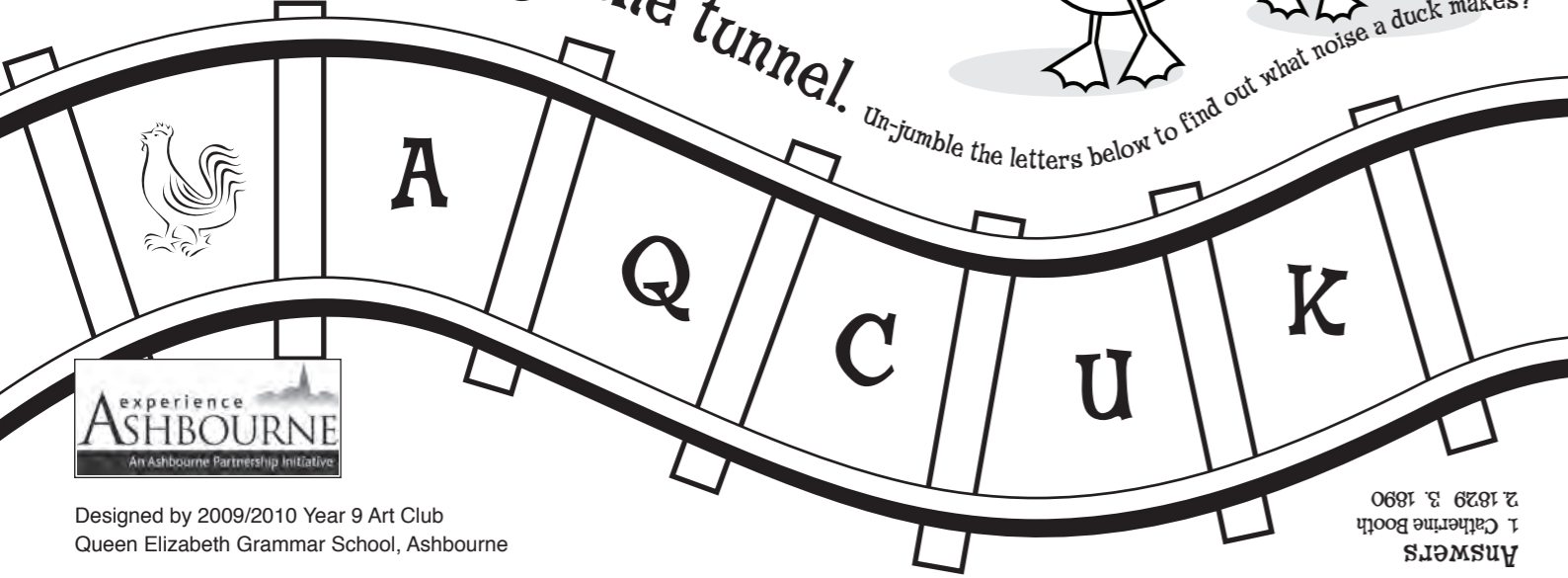

GINGERBREAD MAN

Ingredients

- 350g Plain flour
- 175g Brown sugar
- 100g Butter
- 1 Egg
- 4 tbsp Golden syrup
- 1 tsp Bicarbonate of soda
- 1/2 tsp Ground ginger

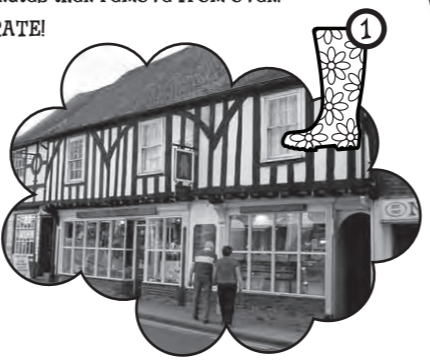
Fantastic gingerbread man recipe

- Put flour, butter, ground ginger and bicarbonate of soda in a mixing bowl. Mix until crumbly.
- Add sugar, syrup and egg and mix until a firm pastry
- Get an adult to preheat oven to 150oC
- Dust work surface with flour and roll out the pastry to 5mm thick
- Cut out pastry in shape of gingerbread man.
- Place cut out pastry on a greased baking tray.
- Bake for for 15 minutes then remove from oven.
- When cool, DECORATE!

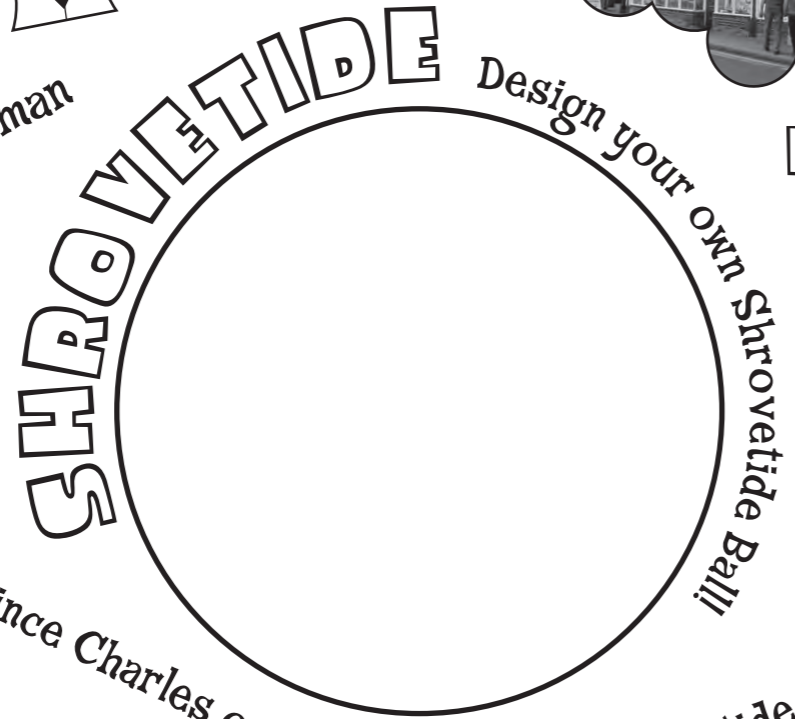
